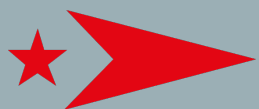

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Host Club: Sundby Sejlforening (SSF) in conjunction with Danish Yngling Association (DYK)

SSF propose to held the Yngling Open World Championship 2023 from July 22nd to 29th, 2023 at Øresund east of Copenhagen.

SSF was successfully hosting the Yngling Open World Championship 1983 in connection with the clubs 60 years anniversary and now we want to host the 2023 championship in connection with our **100 years anniversary**.

SSF is a cozy yacht club with approx. 1200 members and a lot of volunteers to help during the event.

The racing area between Flakfortet and Saltholm is ideal for fair and attractive races; one of the best course areas in Øresund.

Copenhagen as a city is guaranteeing an exciting side program with world famous Tivoli and world class restaurants.

SSF Harbor is located in Copenhagen 5 km from Copenhagen Airport, 6 km from Copenhagen City Hall Square and 500 m from Øresund Metro Station.

Accommodation is available for camping/caravan in the harbor and many hotels up to 5 star level within a range of 200 m to 5 km.

On site facilities of SSF have already proven to be excellent during sailing events.

HISTORY OF SUNDBY SEJLFORENING (SSF)

Founded October 28th, 1923

Approx. 1200 members

The harbor is managed by Sundby Sejlforening.

SSF has a long history with the Int. Yngling Class both as organizer of Yngling race events such as Yngling WC 1983, Yngling Danish Championships and regional Yngling races as well SSF members participating in many Yngling WCs and ECs.

SSF has a reputation of well-organized race events both on the water and ashore.

In 2021 SSF organized Danish Championships for Melges 24 and for Nordic Folkboat.

In 2022 SSF will be organizing Danish Championships for BB10m and for Women's Team Sailing League in J/70.

SSF will in 2023 besides Yngling WC be organizing Women's Sailing Champions League (in September).

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

Christian Lerche is proposed to be chairman of the Race Committee. He is IRO and well known to the Yngling Class.

Karl Petter Haugen is proposed to be Chairman of the International Jury. He is from Norway and an International Jury as per the RRS and well known to the Yngling Class.

The IYA Chief Measurer is proposed to become Chairman of the Championship Measurement Committee.

Jesper Lorents will be Chairman of the Organizing Committee. He is on the board of Sundby Sejlforening, and he has completed the Danish Sailing Association's event leader training. He has been Chairman of the Organizing Committee for several Danish Championships during the last couple of years.

SSF has many members with long experience as volunteers in race events on the water or ashore.



FACILITIES AND SERVICES

SSF will provide sufficient adjacent dockage and moorage for at least a proposed approximate maximum number of Ynglings and a proportional number of coach boats (RIBs).

One 3 t hoist on the pier will be available before and after the championship races.

Dry storage, rigging, measuring and parking areas will be provided.



FACILITIES AND SERVICES

SSF has a clubhouse with a restaurant and meeting facilities for Race Office, Jury etc.

SSF will provide sufficient and suitable boats to perform all race functions including Race Committee boat, mark boats, patrol, towing and if needed spectator boats.

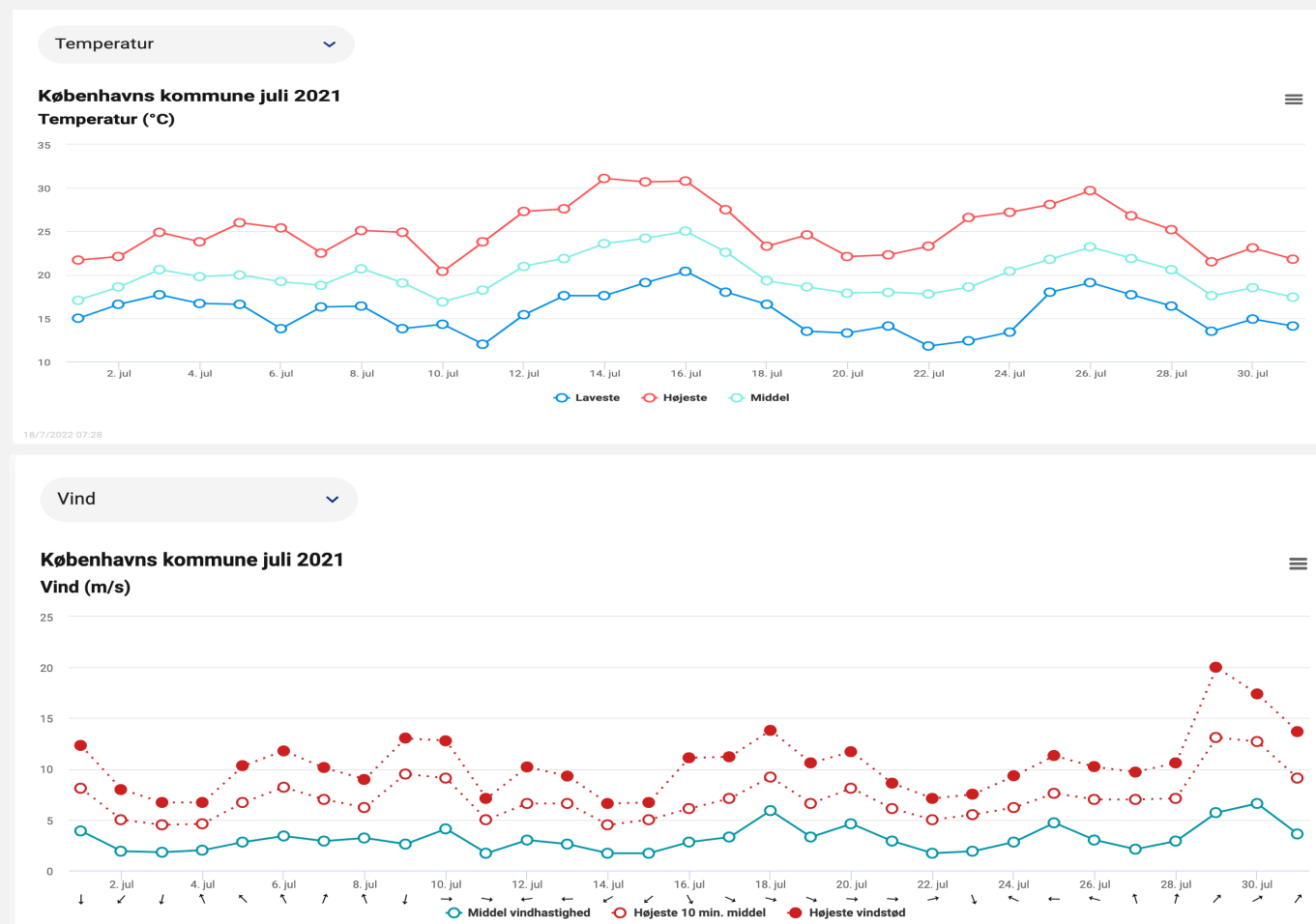

WEATHER CONDITIONS

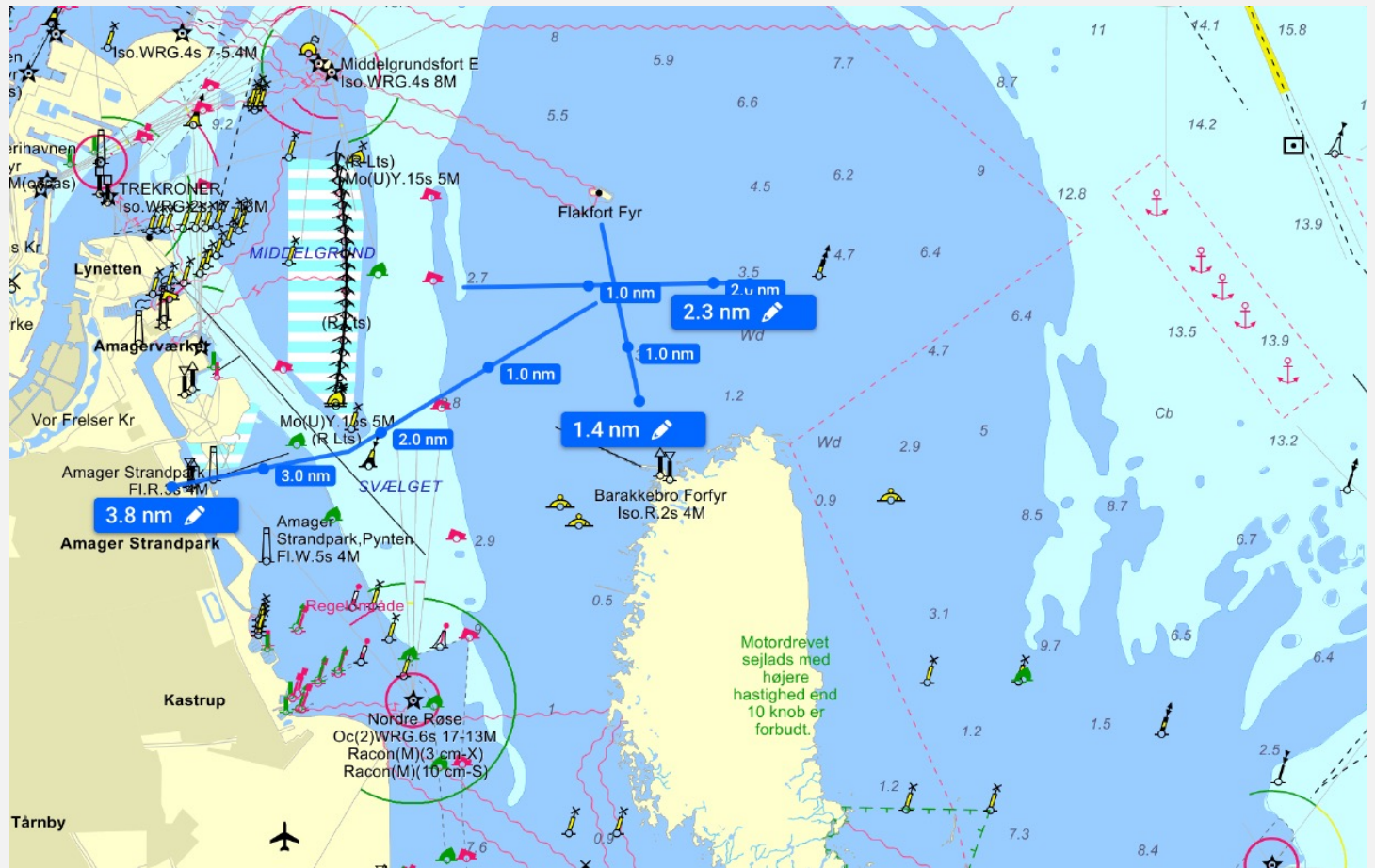
NAUTICAL CHART TO RACE AREA

The race area is located approx. 4 nm east-north-east of SSF harbor between the islands Flakfortet and Saltholm.

Depth is approx. 3 m.

Only little current in the course area even there might be strong current in the deep-water sail gutter west of the course area.

GETTING TO COPENHAGEN

By Car

Distances to Sundby Sejlförening from:

Amsterdam – 800 km, Berlin – 445 km, Brussels – 925 km, Frankfurt – 825 km, Geneva – 1.395 km, Hamburg – 340 km, Koper – 1.500 km, Malmö – 35 km, Munich – 990 km, Oslo – 595 km, Prague – 790 km, Salzburg – 1.135 km, Stockholm – 645 km, Vienna – 1.120 km, Zürich – 1.200 km

By Train

Copenhagen is part of the European rail network and therefore well connected to all parts of Europe.

By Plane

There are scheduled flights from all major European cities to Copenhagen Airport (CPH).

Intercontinental Flights to Copenhagen directly from New York, Chicago, Washington, San Francisco and Dubai or via Frankfurt (FRA), London, Amsterdam (AMS) etc.

Transport from CPH to Sundby Sejlförening via Metro or taxi (only approx. 5 km)



OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

The 'Application for Entry' fee, paid by each NYA to the IYA Secretariat acc. to IYCCR Rule 5.4.2, 6.1 and 6.7, shall be **30 EUR/Boat**. This fee is to cover IYA cost of the championship.

The entry fee paid by each participating boat to the Host Club (SSF) shall be **450 EUR/Boat**. Hoisting, Berthing, Opening Ceremony, Regatta Dinner and Prize Giving Ceremony are included in the entry fee for all 3 crew.

Registration shall be made via the manage2sail.com platform. The Host Club is authorized to accept only entries that are certified by the NYA (or MNA if no NYA) of the skipper concerned.

A limited number of charter boats for overseas and youth teams will be made available through DYK. Information about how to reserve a charter boat, and pricing for it, will be published in the 'Notice of Race'. Boats will be available on a "first come, first reserved" basis.

The maximum number of participating boat will be 70.

Each national team can bring 1 coach boat (RIB) free of charge. Additional or other coach boats and other support boats will be charged the standard SSF guest fee of DKK 150/night.
